SSC, equivalent exams result on July 20

The results of this year's Secondary School Certificate and its equivalent examinations will be published on July 20.

Speaking at a press conference on Monday, education minister ANM Ehsanul Hoque Milon announced that he had already directed the relevant stakeholders and education boards to complete all the necessary preparations.



He also said that no decision was taken to delay the schedule of the SSC and equivalent exams for 2027, currently set to start from January 7, as they had no information of any objection from the stakeholders about the exam schedule.

The press conference was held at the Bangladesh Secretariat, also attended by state minister for primary and mass education Bobby Hajjaj, adviser to the prime minister Mahdi Amin and senior officials of the ministries of education and primary and mass education.

Earlier on June 1, the education minister said that the decision to hold the SSC and equivalent examinations from January 7 next year could be rescheduled if the stakeholders wanted.

At the Monday press conference, the minister also said that the share of education in gross domestic product in the national budget for the coming financial year of 2026–27 will be increased to 2 per cent which was approximately Tk 1.23 lakh crore.

He further said that the viva-voce for recruiting heads of different educational institutions would start soon.

Secondary and Higher Education Division secretary Abdul Khaleque told the press conference that they had got allocation of around Tk 1,600 crore as retirement benefit for the retired teachers under the Monthly Pay Order system.

The money will be distributed among the retired MPO teachers by July, Abdul Khaleque.

The press conference was attended also by primary and mass education ministry secretary Md Shakhawat Hossain, Technical and Madrasah Education Division secretary Md Daud Miah, Directorate of Primary Education director general Shahina Ferdousi , Directorate of Secondary and Higher Education director general Professor Khan Moinuddin Al Mahmud Sohel and other senior officials of both ministries.

The 2026 SSC and equivalent examinations began on April 21 with the theoretical segment concluded on May 20.

The practical examinations are currently under way.

This year, approximately 18.6 lakh examinees from 30,666 educational institutions sat for the examinations.

Education minister on May 14 announced that the 2027 SSC, Higher Secondary Certificate and equivalent examinations would begin on January 7 and June 6 next year, respectively.

The decision has been taken to synchronise the schedules of the two exams to close the gaps that cause students to waste nearly a year as they wait for both SSC and HSC exams and also to ensure their smooth transition into further admission.
