DU suspends 3 teachers, relieves 2 from academic duties

The syndicate of Dhaka University on Monday night decided to temporarily suspend three teachers over allegations of their 'controversial activities' during the July uprising and for allegedly threatening students.

The university has also relieved two more teachers of their academic duties temporarily.



The decisions were taken at a syndicate meeting held on Monday night with vice-chancellor professor ABM Obaidul Islam presiding. Several syndicate members who attended the meeting confirmed the developments.

The teachers temporarily suspended over incidents related to the July uprising are professor Nazmul Ahsan Kalimullah of the Department of Public Administration, professor A K M Jamal Uddin of the Department of Sociology, and professor Shibli Rubayat UllIslam of the Department of Banking and Insurance.

One of teachers temporarily relieved from academic duties is Mohammad Azmal Hossain Bhuiyan over his alleged involvement in the July uprising-related incidents.

The other is Tashrik-e-Habib, a teacher who drew attention for singing on social media.

Dhaka University pro-vice-chancellor (administration) Mohammed Almujaaddade Alfasane said that the decisions were taken based on the opinion of the legal adviser.

He added that an investigation committee is also formed to conduct a further inquiry into the allegations against the four teachers.

The university administration has also temporarily suspended university official Lavlu Molla Shishir alias Muhammad Lavlu Molla, on the same allegations.

At the syndicate meeting, professor Chowdhury Md Tashrik-e-Habib of the Department of Bangla was relieved from academic activities in line with the recommendation of the department's academic council.

He had gone viral on social media for singing, triggering widespread criticism on the campus, there are also allegations of financial misconduct against him.

The syndicate also decided to send to the legal adviser the issue of cancelling the Dhaka University Central Students' Union general secretary post of Golam Rabbani, elected in the 2019 DUCSU election, on the ground that he did not possess valid studentship at the time.
