BCTA slates assault on teachers on duty

Principal A.K.M Shahidul-lah and Professor M Shariful Islam, President and Secretary General respectively of the Bangladesh College Teachers Association expressed strong resentment at the heinous attack by the unruly elements and outsiders on the teachers who were conducting the HSC examination at the Toltram College Centre and the innocent examinees, says a Press release.
