Brojomohon College faces various problems

BARISAL, Jan. 11: Government Brojomohon University College here is beset with manifold problems. The college was established in 1889 by late Aswari Kumer Datta.

Shortage of teaching staff is an acute problem. Seventeen posts have been lying vacant for the last five years. As a result students are facing untold sufferings. Arabic and Islamic Studies department are running without any teacher.

ACCOMMODATION

Acute Crisis of accommodation for teaching staff and students is prevailing since long. The teachers have to reside outside college compound. There are five hostels with 300 seats as against about 5,000 students. Over one thousand students are now residing in the hostels facing many troubles. Moreover no hostel has yet been constructed for female students numbering about 2,000. They recently occupied the vacant principal's quarter and turned it as the female hostel. After getting assurance from the authority they however vacated the quarter.

SUPPLY OF WATER, POWER

Disruption of power supply

has become a regular feature causing sufferings to the students. Hardly a day or night passes without disruption of power supply. In case of drinking water also this picture may be drawn.

CLASS ROOM

It is apprehended that some classes may be suspended for want of class room in near future. The chief engineer, PWD asked the authority not to use the building as it might cause accident at any time.

As there is no common room for the students the auditorium is being used for the purpose.

A miserable condition is prevailing in the library reading room. There is no arrangement here for the students to read sitting. No furniture is there. As a result the rich library is not coming to any use to the students.

The college had a good name and fame in the past. Many students earned reputation from the college. This good name is being faded away as the college is now facing problems and its educational atmosphere is being hampered.
