

## DU degree exams begin tomorrow

The degree pass and subsidiary examination of Dacca University of 1981 will begin tomorrow (Thursday).

In all, 25,500 candidates have been enrolled for the examination recording an increase of more than 3,000 students over last years. Out of the total candidates 14,950 will appear at the BA examination, 6,025 at the BSc while 4,525 will sit for the B. Com examination in the 37 examination centres. A total of 9,680 candidates will appear from the seven examination centres in the city.

An inspection team has been formed for the city centres to observe the proceedings of examination and to report as to

whether the examination is conducted according to the rules and regulations of the University. Special invigilators have been appointed by the university authority for full time duty at the Jagannath College and Shaheed Suhrawardy College examination centres.

The Deputy Commissioner of Dacca, who is the supervising officer of the degree examination centres in the city has deputed magistrates to maintain law and order in the centres.

It has been decided that there will be no examination centres under the jurisdiction of the Dacca University below the level of sub-divisional headquarters from the examination of 1982 to maintain uniformity in the standard of conducting the degree examinations.
