

HSC exam from today

The Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Examination of 1981 will commence from today (Thursday) all over the country. Over one lakh candidates will appear at the examination under four Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education: Dacca, Comilla, Jessore and Raishahi.

The examinations will start from 10 a. m. and continue till 1 p. m. while the afternoon shift will be from 2 p. m. till 5 p. m.

A total of 39,878 candidates will be appearing for the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination from the Dacca Board.

The examination will be held at 71 centres under the board. Of the total candidates 31,995 are male and the rest 7,883 are female.

A total of 16,864 will be appearing from the Arts group, 16,791 from the Science group, 5,316 from the Commerce group, 188 from the Home Economics group, 699 from Agricultural group, 17 from Islamic Education group and 13 from Musical group.

It may be mentioned here that from the current year, three centres have been set up abroad. The centres abroad are one each at Tripoli, Jeddah and London.

In metropolitan Dacca city 12,124 candidates will appear at 20 sub-centres.

It may be recalled that a total number of 36,837 candidates appeared for the HSC Examination of 1980 from 71 centres.

A five member Vigilance Committee had been set up with the District Commissioners as the conveners of the committee for holding the examination smoothly.

Meanwhile, 30,487 candidates will appear for the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination from Comilla Board today (Thursday).

Of the total 25,858 are male candidates while 4,629 are female candidates.

The examination will be held at 100 centres under the board.

It may be recalled that a total of 25,000 candidates appeared for the HSC Examination of 1980.

From the Jessore Board a total of 28,541 candidates will appear for the HSC Examination from 83 centres.

Of the total 24,123 are male while the rest 4,418 are female.
