

58.71 p.c. pass Jessore HSC Board Exams

JESSORE Sept. 14.—The results of the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Examinations held this year under the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Jessore were announced today.

A total of 27,146 candidates appeared at the examinations of which 15,940 came out, successful percentage of pass being 58.71.
