Lecturers in English For Govt. Colleges

Sir. — From a reliable source it is learnt that a good many posts of lecturers in English lie vacant at different government colleges. In many of the colleges lecturers in English are fewer than necessary. Teaching staff in this department are always insufficient in comparison to other departments. With the nationalisation of all Sub-divisional colleges the problem has increased further. As a result English teaching is being seriously hampered. So appointment of lecturers in English is a crying need at present for the wholesome atmosphere of education. Bangladesh Public Service Commission advertised for 90 posts of lecturers in English in May, 1961. But the date of test for the posts has not yet been announced. So far it is learnt that the number of applicants for such posts is below than what was advertised. So there is the possibility for re-advertisement. If the report is true the authority may make an advertisement. The relevant authority is therefore earnestly requested to advertise for the posts and schedule the date of interview soon. —Yours, etc. MD. NAZRUL ISLAM SARKER Manikganj, Dacca.
