

Nationalisation of colleges by 1985 urged

Bangladesh College Teachers Association (BCTA) on Friday called upon the Government to take effective steps for the nationalisation of college education by 1985 in conformity with the decisions of the National Education Advisory Council (NEAC), according to a Press release of the association.

It was contained in a resolution adopted at the three-day silver jubilee celebration and biennial conference of the BCTA which ended on Thursday. In another resolution it was decided to take definite programmes for movement on January 8, 1981 if the provisions of the agreement signed between the Bangladesh Federation of Teachers Association and the Government regarding uniform pay scale and service rules for non-government college teachers were not implemented by December 25, 1980.

The election of the National Executive Council of the BCTA for 1980-82 was held on Thursday. Principal A K M Shahidullah and Prof M Shareeful Islam were elected as President and Secretary General respectively, the Press release said.
