SSC exams held in peaceful atmosphere

The Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations under the four education boards began all over the country on Thursday.

On the day the examinations were held in a peaceful atmosphere and no untoward incident was reported.

However, five candidates were expelled for adoption of unfair means in the examination hall under Dacca Board. Of them two were from the Mirpur Bangla Medium High School centre, one from Banglabazar Sarkari Balika Bidyalaya centre and two others from the Gazipur centre.

The Controller of Examinations of Dacca Board told the Times that the conduct of the examinations was upto the mark on the opening day.

He congratulated the district administration of Dacca for its active cooperation in holding the examinations properly.

The Secretary of Jessore Board said that the examinations were peaceful and till 9 p.m last night no expulsion was reported under his board.
