### //Redefining concept of EDN urged

Speakers at a seminar Thursday called for redefining the concept of education aiming at broadening of mind, inception and development of new ideas, reports UNB.

The seminar entitled Village School in Bangladesh Caught Between Tradition and Change was organised by the Centre for Development Research, Bangladesh (CDRB) in association with American Institute of Bangladesh Studies (AIBS).

AIBS visiting senior research fellow Dr Sharmin S Khan presented the key note paper at the seminar with CDRB Chairman Dr Mizanur Rahman Shelly in the chair.

Held at the auditorium of Women's Voluntary Association, the seminar was addressed, among others, by Nuruddin M Kamal, Prof Syed Anwar Hossain, Dr Kazi Anwara Monsoor, Tazin Hossain and Dr Naimuddin.

Dr Sharmin who found two types of village schools in the country-government running primary schools and BRAC's Non-formal Primary Education programme, called for paying closer attention at the class room level.
