

Action plan prepared to make primary education dynamic

Education Minister ASHK Sadique has laid emphasis on an effective primary education system to ensure the quality of education and create efficient manpower, reports UNB.

He was addressing the opening session of a workshop on "national action plan of distance education for the training of primary teachers", at the Planning and Development Academy auditorium Sunday.

The function was addressed, among others, by Secretary Primary and Mass Education Division Syed Amir-ul-Mulk, team leader of the national action plan committee SM Al Hussain, former Director of Bangladesh Distance Education Institute Dr KM Shirajul Islam and Joint Secretary of Primary and Mass Education Division AHM Sadiqul Haq.

Eminent educationists and specialists with the help of ADB, UNICEF and UNESCO has prepared the draft of the national action plan which is expected to ensure the primary
