Kurigram Mahila College

Kurigram Government Mahila College was established as an Intermediate College in 1973. Subsequently it was upgraded to Degree College with Arts and Science. And the college was nationalised in the year 1984. But since its nationalisation, nothing has been done for the development of the college.

The most important problem is accommodation. Due to increase in students' strength the existing tin sheds can not accommodate the students. And, moreover, the tin sheds are old and worn out and some rooms of the hostel building are being used as classrooms.

The Science Laboratory is

ill equipped and the students do not have sportsgear for sports. The college does not have an auditorium. Moreover the college library does not have sufficient books for the students.

The sanctioned post of the teaching staff are 34. But at the moment there are only 27 teaching staff to teach 400 girls. And it is learnt that the teachers and staff are not getting salary for a long time.

The Education Minister is therefore requested to look into the matter and take necessary steps for the improvement of Kurigram Mahila College.
