200 madrashas to be developed

RAOZAN, Deputy Minister for Education Ziauddin Ahmed and Mr. Bablu laid stress on ensuring proper utilisation of the funds.

Bablu said here Thursday that two hundred madrashas would be developed under Science Education Project during the current Third Five-Year Plan period.

He said this while he was addressing a gathering of students, teachers and guardians at the premises of Muniria Darus Sunnah Madrasha and Orphanage here.

Presided over by Raozan Upazila Parishad Chairman Mr M Abdullah, the gathering was also addressed, among others, by the UNO of Raozan.

Referring to Universal Primary Education, the Deputy Minister for Education said that the Government had already distributed 92 lakh sets of books this year among the primary school going students throughout the country.

Maintenance of congenial environment is the pre-condition for the dissemination of education, he said, adding any sorts of corruption, instability and anarchy in educational institutions would seriously impede the studies of the students —BSG
