### **A University For Woman!**

Sir,

Your recent editorial under the above heading has attracted our attention. Thank you for presenting your viewpoint on such an important subject.

But we cannot agree with you on your editorial comment that a separate and exclusive university for woman is not, at the moment, practicable in the plea of difficulty to find out enough qualified women staff.

Our view in this regard, is that, no difficulty or problem is solved or removed by itself unless and until the work is started and continued. To have the Eden Girls' College converted into a fullfledged women's university is the crying need of the hour. To fill-up the dearth of women staff, the male teachers may easily be hired or posted in limited numbers. In course of time, the female students doing brilliant results from the university are to be picked up as teachers on a regular basis.

The Home Economics university college may be merged with the proposed university. The matter is so urgent that mere upgradation of Eden Girls' College shall not serve the purpose. It should be recalled that, Chittagong University and Jahangir Nagar University could not introduce their system of examination as well as the system of education overnight without the help and co-operation of the existing ones.

The suggestions recommendations by a daily like the Bangladesh Observer are expected to be more pragmatic.
