Varsity teachers boycott classes for 2 hours

Teachers of the country's six universities will boycott classes today (Monday) for two hours demanding repeal of the Educational Institutions Ordinance (Law and Order), 1990, reports UNB.

Teachers of Dhaka, Rajshahi, Chittagong, Jahangirnagar, Agriculture and Engineering Universities will take part in the two-hour token boycott of classes from 10 a.m. to 12 noon.

The Bangladesh Federation of University Teachers Association (BFUTA) gave the call for the token strike at a rally at the Central Shaheed Minar here on November 13 as part of its 10-day action programme against the Ordinance.
