call for strike

BCS General Education Association has called for a day-long work abstention on January 20 (Thursday) across the country to protest the Tuesday's killing of a teacher of Sunamganj Government College by a degree examinee, reports UNB.

Joyanta Kumar Dey, a teacher of Physics Department of the College, was stabbed to death by the degree examinee whom he had earlier not allowed to adopt unfair means in the examination.

The decision of the day-long work abstention by the Government college teachers was taken at the emergency meeting of the BCS General Education Association held on Friday with Association President Dr. QATM Habibur Rahman in the chair.

The meeting strongly condemned the killing and demanded exemplary punishment to the identified killer and adequate compensation to the victim's family.

It also expressed grave concern at the failure of the authorities to ensure safety and security of the invigilators in the examination centres.
