Higher edn to be expanded: Sircar

Education Minister Jamiruddin Sircar on Friday said the present democratic government aimed at reaching the opportunity of higher education to the door-steps of the rural people through introducing honours and Master-degree courses in the colleges located at greater district towns, reports BSS.
