BFTA concern over SSC exams

Bangladesh Federation of Teachers Association (BFTA) on Wednesday expressed concern as the SSC examinations under five boards of the country are going to begin on March 28 amid political unrest, reports UNB.

In a joint statement, BFTA Chairman and Secretary General urged the board authorities to discuss the issue with the political leaders whether the examinations will begin on March 28 or not.

They said the essential materials for holding the examinations have not yet been sent to the examination centres.

Official sources said some 4.76 lakh examinees will appear in the SSC examinations under the five boards this year.

Boardwise break-up of the examinees are Dhaka Board: 1.41 lakh, Rajshahi Board: 1.20 lakh, Jessore Board: 85,000 and Chittagong and Comilla Board: 1.30 lakh.
