Blue Panel sweeps DU senate polls

Pro-Awami League 'Blue Panel' swept the election of the teachers' representatives to the Dhaka University Senate bagging 27 out of 35 posts. Pro-BNP White Panel won five posts while independent 'Pink Panel' took three.

A total of 111 candidates from four panels contested for 35 posts of teachers' representatives in 105-member DU senate. Another White Panel backed by Jamaat fought for only six posts but failed to bag any post.

The candidates came out successful from 'Pink Panel' are prof AKM Sad Uddin of Sociology Department (367 votes), Dr. Abdul Momin Chowdhury of History (334 votes) and Dr. Aminul Islam of Philosophy Department (380 votes):

A total of 903 voters cast their vote in the election to choose 35 teachers representatives for three years term. The election held at the Dhaka University Teachers Student Centre (TSC) on Thursday was conducted by the Election Commissioner Prof. M. Shamsul Haq, Treasurer of the University.

BSS adds: According to the Article 20 (1) of the Dhaka University Ordinance '73 the elected teachers will be representatives to the Senate for the next three years.

The senate headed by Vice-Chancellor play a key role in the decision making of the university.

The other members of the Senate include Pro-Vice-Chancellor, Treasurer, five government officials selected by the government, five members from the Jatiya Sangsad, five educationists selected by the Chancellor five researchers selected by the syndicate, Chairman of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board of Dhaka and 25 registered graduate representatives elected by the university, graduates.
