

Teacher shortage in Borguna Govt College

BARGUNA, Mar. 10:—The Borguna Government College, only institution of higher education in the district, is beset with manifold problems, reports UNB.

Education is being hampered due to shortage of teachers, classrooms and necessary appliances in the college. There are no dormitories for students and teachers and no auditorium for holding cultural functions. Besides there is acute shortage of books in the college library.

Most of the departments in the college are facing shortage of teachers. The college has no quarters for the principal, vice-principal and hostel superintendent.

The principal and other teachers reside in small tinsheds beside the college compound. Moreover, the college has no dormitory for girl students.

Although it is a government college but no government money has been sanctioned for the construction of official quarters.

The women's common room is in a deplorable condition. A large number of girl students find no adequate accommodation in the old common room. Besides, there are no arrangements for any indoor games.

The students demanded introduction of honours courses in the college for long but no step has been taken in this regard and as a result the poor meritorious students have been deprived of higher education.
