

BUET students for suspension of classes during WC

Hundreds of World Cup soccer fans at Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology yesterday defied a call of the authorities to join the classes, BUET sources said, reports BSS.

All academic activities were suspended and classes could not be held due to protests from the students, they added.

The classes were scheduled to resume yesterday after month-long stalemate on the campus.

On Saturday night, a big procession paraded the campus demanding suspension of classes during the World Cup.

"It is not at all possible to appear in the class tests or to do other academic activities after having a late night for World
