

23 hurt in Ctg exam centres: 249 expelled

CHITTAGONG, Mar. 21:—At least 23 persons including the Officer-in-Charge of Banskhalī thana were injured when police clashed with unruly outsiders at the SSC examination centres at Mirershorai, Banskhalī and Rauzan upazilas on Sunday. The police opened eight rounds of gun fire at Mirershorai Sadar Upazila to disperse unruly people who attacked the examination centre. The police also resorted to lathi-charge and tear gas shells to disperse the intruders at Banskhalī and Rauzan upazila centres.

Mr. Shah Alam, Officer-in-Charge of Banskhalī thana received serious injuries when he confronted some outsiders at the examination centre. He is now undergoing treatment at a private clinic in Chittagong city.

About 30 examinees have so far been expelled in Chittagong district for adopting unfair means in the examination.

Narail

Our Correspondent adds:—A least 69 candidates were expelled from

different centres of Narail district for adopting unfair means in the SSC examination till Sunday. Of the expelled candidates, 17 are from Narail, eight from Lohagara, and 44 from Kalia centres.

Three thousand fifty one candidates are taking part in the examination throughout the district.

Kurigram

In Kurigram 120 candidates including 20 girls were expelled on the first and second day of examination for adopting unfair means in the halls. Of them 30 were expelled from Rajarhat, 25 from Nageswari, 18 from Kurigram, 16 from Ulipur, 14 from Rajibpur, 11 from Chilmari, 3 from Bhurungamri, 2 from Rowmari and 1 from Fulbari centre.

Meanwhile on the third day of SSC examination under the Dhaka Board 30 students were expelled for adopting unfair means at Rajbari on Monday.
