No hostel for Daulatpur students

DAULATPUR, Mar. 12.—The students of Daulatpur town have been facing inconvenience to a great extent for want of hostel accommodation. There are two high schools—one for boys and the other for girls. The boys' school has got a hostel which can at least accommodate only twenty-five students. Each year large number of students undergo a lot of trouble for want of it and as such they have to go back disappointed.

The said hostel needs expansion. For want of adequate funds it cannot

be expanded. The girls' school which has over 800 students on its roll has no hostel. The number of students is increasing day by day. But many ambitious girl students find it very difficult to continue their studies for want of hostel facilities.

The guardians have been very much worried as they cannot do anything for their awards for want of hostel accommodation. It is also surprising to note that there is no accommodation facilities in this school for lady teachers.
