Students clash at Ctg: one killed

CHITTAGONG, March 27: One student was killed and several others were injured when rival groups of students clashed at several educational institutions here today, reports BSS.

The clash took place in Government Commerce College, Chittagong Government College and Government Mohsin College in the city.

Addressing a press conference at the local Press Club this evening, the City Unit President of Islami Chhatra Shibir Farid Uddin Khan claimed that Jashim Uddin (18), a first year honours student of Commerce College and 22 other workers of his organisation was injured by open armed attack by supporters of Chhatra Sangram Parishad. He said that the miscreants allegedly fired on Shibir workers while some of them were filing nomination papers for students union elections scheduled to be held on April 3.

Meanwhile in a separate press release, Chhatra Sangram Parishad claimed that 40 workers of the parishad were injured. One student was killed and one of their leading workers was kidnapped by Shibir members in Commerce College, Chittagong College and Mohsin College.

The Sangram Parishad called a 6 am to 12 noon. hartal

in the city tomorrow to protest against what they said armed attack on their workers by Shibir supporters.

Both Sangram Parishad and Chhatra Shibir blamed each other saying that they were out to undo April 3 students union elections of the three colleges.
