Students clash, ten injured

At least ten students and some policemen were injured following a violent clash between the students of Dhaka College and City College on Saturday. The clash originated over the strike call of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) in all educational institutions of the country in protest against the killing of Habibur Rahman Kabir.

The City College students earlier announced that they won't observe the strike. The students of Dhaka College became angry at this and attacked the City College. The street from New Market to Science Laboratory became a battle field following chase counter chase and bomb explosions. The clash started at 11 a.m. and continued till 1 p.m.

Complete strike was observed in Dhaka and Engineering Universities on Saturday at the call of JCD in protest against the killing of Kabir in Jahangirnagar University. JCD alleged that the armed members of Islami Chhatra Shibir killed Kabir and created a reign of terror in all educational institutions of the country.

DU students asked to carry ID Cards

Meanwhile all students of the Dhaka University have been asked to carry their Identity Cards with them, says a DU press release.

The students, who have not yet procured their Identity Cards due to delay in admission process, have been directed to collect their Identity Cards from the Departmental chairman.
