

## Rubana compelled to leave DU examination hall

Rubana Ahmed, a student of First Year Honours in the Department of English at Dhaka University was compelled to leave the examination hall in the Arts Faculty Building on Thursday by a section of students. This was the expression of their resentment against Rubana's participation in Bangladesh Television programmes following November 28 incident in the city.

Since November 28 Rubana continued to abstain from attending her classes in the University fearing such an unpleasant circumstance. She came in the campus for the first time on Thursday to appear in her in-course examination, which began at third floor of Arts Faculty Building at 10 a.m. on the day.

Coming to know of Rubana's presence in the campus some students gathered in front of the examination hall and tried to force their entry into it. Teachers present there however, tried to restrain them and urged them to allow the students in the hall to go through their examinations peacefully.

Size of the crowd swelled and tension began to mount around the examination hall. At one stage a group of students entered the hall and tried to assault Rubana.

Modhu's canteen soon came to know of the incident and rushed to the spot. They managed to bring the angry and agitating students under control and escorted Rubana out of the examination hall to avoid any further deterioration of the situation.

Leaders of the central Students Action Committee and the teachers at the examination hall cordoned and escorted her to the car park and put her into a waiting car.

Rubana was followed by a large number of jeering students. Some of the boys tried to pull her out of the car but failed due determined efforts by both the teachers and student leaders. They pelted stones on the car which sped away.
