### JCD leader killed in city

At least one person was killed and two others were injured in separate incidents in the city on Sunday.

Syed Mohammad Khokan (26) President of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) Bakshibazar Alia Madrasa unit was fatally injured when a group of armed miscreants fired several rounds of gunshots at him.

According to witnesses, some youths came to the Alia Madrasa hostel by a microbus at Bakshibazar at 11:30 am and called Khokan out of his room.

At one stage of altercation arms miscreants shorts fired at him. He received bullets in his head and abdomen. Khokan was rushed to Dhaka Medical College Hospital in a critical condition where he succumbed to his injuries at about 12:30 pm.

He was a student of Kamal Tafshir Department, and son of Syed Iqbalur Rahman, of Amulia under Demra thana. His father was an employee of BUET. His body was brought to his residence at Demra after autopsy. No case was filed with Lalbagh police station till filing on this report at 10 pm.

When contacted the duty officer of Lalbagh thana told the Bangladesh Times at 10 am that none was arrested in connection with the incident so far.

In another incident Belayet Hossian (25) and Ashraf (26) receive serious burn injuries when they fell on a live electric wire at Mauchuk Market area at about 5pm in the city on Sunday.

According to witnesses, victims masons by profession were working on the roof of an under-construction building.
