Release of BUET students demanded

The President of Bangladeshi University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) Teacher's Association, Prof. Mizanul Hoque called upon the students community and the people in general to lend their support to the 5-point demand and work for its success. He was speaking at a protest rally held at BUET Shahid Minar on Thursday.

Criticising the present Government Prof. Hoque said the government was trying to create unpleasant situation in the educational institutions. Referring to the present strike called by school teachers he said only a democratic government could solve the problems in the country and restore academic atmosphere on the campus.

Addressing the rally DUCSU VP and CSAC leader Mr. Akhtaruzzaman said that students would continue their relentless fight like that of 1969 for establishing democracy in the country.

Presided over by Students Action Committee (SAC) leader Mr. Muniruzzaman Mohon, the rally was also addressed by BUET Employee's Association leader Sekandar Hayat Chowdhury, students leaders Nikhil Guha, Muniruzzaman Munir and Zulfiqar Hossain Bokul.

In a resolution the rally strongly condemned the government action and demanded immediate release of arrested students to ensure congenial atmosphere in the university.
