# 1,115 posts of primary teachers lying vacant in Khulna

NOAPARA, Jan. 11:—Over 115 posts of primary school teachers in 16 district under Khulna Division have been lying vacant for a long time.

The shortage of teacher has been hampering the education of children in the primary schools.

The district-wise vacant posts of Primary teachers are as follows: 112 teachers in Khulna, 48 in Narail, 17 in Magura, 47 in Jhenidah, 137-in Jessore, 83 in Bagherhat, 73-in Satkhira 88-in Chuadanga, 29-in Meherpur, 125-in Kushtia, 125-in Barisal 45-in Jhalakhati, 73-in Pirojpur 38-in Barguna, 90-in Bhola, and 71-in Patuakhali district.

## Smuggled goods

The Customs Preventive Unit- Jessore has recovered a huge quantity of smuggled goods which included INDIAN sarees, blouse pieces three pieces, Sugar, Cosmetics, insecticide medicine, steel plate, steel glass seen spare-aparts etc worth about Tk 24,56,156 during the last one year beginning from January 1 to December 31, 1989. ## Drug addiction

Indian fencydil syrup has become popular among the drunkards in South-western region of the country.

The Indian cough syrup fencydil containing atleast 92 per cent Alcohol sold at the rate of Tk. 35. Per bottle has occupied the Jessor Bana-pole Zhikorgasa, Sarsa, Kolaroa Satkhira markets. It is available in all shops and medicine-stores.

Youths the age group of 15 to 27 are found taking fencydil freely in hotels and restaurants.

While contacted some drunkards informed me that Fencydil syrup is the cheapest drug which is available at Taka 35.

At least 62 to 71 per cent drunkards are eager to take Fencydil as drinking.

Family disturbance, unemployment, Social Unrest and transformation are the main causes of drinking alcohol.

## Bus looted

A Chaugasā bound minibus coming from Jessore arrived at Churammonkhali when a gang of dacoits numbering about 6/7 stopped the bus and looted Tk 1000 in cash and valuables worth a Tk. 25000 from passenger at knife Point on January 3.

Sarsa police recovered body of one Abu Bakar Siddiqi of village Ghiga on January 1. The body bore stab injuries.
