

36,000 apply for 1,115 posts of Pry. teachers

BARISAL, Jan. 19:—More than 36,000 applications have been received against 1115 vacant posts of primary teachers in 15 southern districts of the country, reports UNB.

According to official sources, 5,500 applications have been received against 125 posts in Barisal, 110 for 45 posts in Jhalakati, 2095 against 71 posts in Patuakhali, 1385 for 38 posts in Barguna and 2661 for 70 posts in Pirojpur districts.

In Kushtia, 2537 applications were received against 125 posts, 734 applications against 29 posts in Meherpur, 1166 for 38 posts in Chaudanga, 2400 for 73 posts in Satkhira, 2833 for 83 posts in Bagerhat, 4028 against 122 posts in Khulna, 1311 for 48 posts in Narail, 1147 for 17 posts in Magura, 1690 for 47 posts in Jhenidah and 3894 for 137 posts in Jessore districts.

There are 300 students and 5 teachers in the School. The roof of the School building will collapse at any moment, it is apprehended.

It would be beter to mention here that due to lack of furniture (bench) and accomodation students sit on either mats or bricks under open sky.

In this adverse situation, teachers are being compelled to leave the school.

The education loving people of Abhoynagar upazila urged the authority concerned to come forward to give government's recognition to the school to make the Univerasal Education programme a success to achieve the target of education for all within 2000.
