Non-govt school teachers observe token Strike

Non-Government secondary school teachers and employees observed token strike all over the country on Wednesday at the call of Bangladesh Shikkhak Samity (Teachers Association), said a Press release.

Bangladesh Shikkhak Samity gave the strike call to press its seven-point demands including establishment of a progressive, democratic and neutral education policy in the country.

In Dhaka, the teachers brought out a procession from the National Press Club and paraded some important thoroughfares of the city. The procession was followed by a brief rally in front of the Central Shaheed Minar.

Presided over by President of the organisation Mr. Quamruzzaman, the rally was addressed among others by General Secretary Mrs. Hena Das, and other leaders Alauddin Bhuiyan, Abu Bakar Siddique and Abu Hamid Shahabuddin.

The speakers demanded immediate acceptance of the seven point demands of the non-government secondary teachers of the country.
