on a statement by the Principal of the college said here tonight.

The statement said the trouble makers destroyed whatever they found in the room of the Principal, the Vice-Principal, Teachers auditorium and set on fire important papers and did not spare even the laboratory equipment. They damaged properties worth Taka ten lakh, the statement said.

They wanted to foil the democratic elections in the college and some ex-students who are no more the lawful students of the college, resorted to there heinous acts after the authorities had rejected some of their unjustified demands like re-admission of some old students before the coming elections of the college union. They wanted to force their decisions despite the fact that such demands were in contravention of the rules and agreed guidelines.

The statement said the looters also looted the house of the Principal. They had earlier tried to prevent the filing of nomination papers by intending candidates for the elections.
