## Call to fulfil Rokeya Hall students' demands

The students residing in Rokeya Hall of the University of Dacca urged the university authorities to fulfil their 4-point demands in a statement issued on Thursday.

The Provost's office of the hall which was locked on October 7 by the hall students to press their demands are still under lock and key. They said that they would not unlock office until their demands were met.

The four-point demands of the students included reinstatement of Mrs. Razia Khan Amin former Provost of the hall, expulsion of the three students responsible for the incident of the hall where some students were severely beaten up and the seven guards involved in the incident.

They also urged upon the authorities to publish the report of the inquiry committee. Earlier various students organisations and groups had urged upon the authorities to fulfil the genuine demands of the general students of the hall.
