

RU happenings pre-planned, say 51 MPs-elect

Fifty-one MP-elect and 19 Central Committee members of the Bangladesh Nationalist Party in a joint statement on Friday said that people do not support the happening at Rajshahi created by certain student organisations.

The people termed the incident as a pre-planned conspiracy. They said that as in the past they have full sympathy and support for the genuine demands and problems of the students. They said "we want to state clearly that it is not correct that all movements will turn into a mass movement." Because the agents of expansionism and hegemonism will resort to conspiracy taking advantage of the problems. They called upon the students to pay attention to such conspiracy. The statement also said that the peace loving and innocent students may be misled by cheap slogans of hegemonism and expansionism. It further said that the political changes and change of government in recent time in Asia, Africa, and other Third World countries were due to conspiracy and aggression of the social imperialism is clear to the people of Bangladesh. The incident at Rajshahi is also not an isolated one, the statement observed.

The statement further said that a few defeated enemies were conspiring to retard the process towards establishment of democracy. This anti-people forces may lead the country to an uncertainty creating chaos. They called upon the people to resist this challenge. The state
