

Dacca HSC exams put off

The on-going Higher Secondary Certificate Examinations (HSC) under the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Dacca, have been postponed from today (Monday) due to unavoidable circumstances, says a Press release issued by the Controller of Examinations of the BISE on Sunday.

The revised programmes of the examinations of the remaining papers will be announced soon, the Press release added.

Earlier, when contacted, the Chairman of the BISE told The Bangladesh Observer that the

decision of the postponement of the examinations was taken in view of the reports of alleged leakage of the question papers. The decision was taken at a meeting of the Examination Committee of the Board, he said. However, the Board is yet to take any decision as regards the examinations of the six papers already held, the chairman said.

It may be mentioned here that a total of 36,850 H.S.C. candidates were appearing at the examinations this year.

The Bangladesh Observer on Sunday night received a number of telephone calls from the anxious guardians about the postponement of the H.S.C. examinations.
