

## Edn. Ministry officials urged to work with zeal

Prime Minister Shah Azizur Rahman on Thursday urged the officers and employees of the Education Ministry to work with missionary zeal for the success of the second phase of Revolution aiming at the eradication of illiteracy from the country in the next five years, reports BSS.
