Best lyricist: Amjad Hossain for his song "Haire Kapal Mondo" in "Golapi". Best art director: Mohiuddin Faroque for "Dumurer Phool". Best male singer: Syed Abdul Hadi for his song "Achen Amar Mokhter" in "Golapi". Best female singer: Sabina Yasmin for her song "Haire Kapal Mondo" in "Golapi" and "Dukha Amar Bushar Rater Alanka" in "Alanka". Best child artist: Master Shakil in "Dumurer Phool" and Master Suman in "Ashikhila". No award was given for the best sound recordist as none was considered upto the mark.
