

HSC exam revised schedule may be announced today

The revised schedule for the current HSC examinations of the Dacca Education Board is likely to be announced today (Wednesday).

The Board authorities in consultation with the Ministry of Education is now completing the necessary formalities to make the announcement.

Meanwhile, the meeting of cross section of educationists at the Board office on Tuesday sought concrete government assurance that the law enforcing agencies would be more active to ensure law and order during examinations.

The educationists at the meeting opined that sale of question papers could have been stopped by way of deterrent measures like arrest and punishment of the persons connected with the offence before such question papers were widely circulated.

The educationists also sought enough security arrangement for the teachers on invigilation duties so that they could effectively check adoption of unfair means in the examination halls.

They also urged the Government to immediately institute a committee headed by a judge of the High Court or the Supreme Court to enquire into the leakage of questions of the current HSC Examinations.

The educationists called for special arrangement to take the remaining examinations as early as possible so that the results of the HSC Examinations under the Board could be published in keeping with the time tables of three other education boards in the country.

Meanwhile, a reliable source told the Times that the board authorities was making an effort to resume the current examinations by July 12 or 13.
