

## Pay scales body for non-govt teachers meets

The high-level committee constituted by the Government recently, with Kazi Anwarul Haque, Adviser to the President as Chairman, to examine the feasibility and other aspects of the introduction of uniform minimum pay scales for non-government educational institutions held a number of sessions, says an official handout, reports BSS.

The committee met on Sunday in the cabinet room of the secretariat and heard the representatives of the Bangladesh Shikshak Samity Federation, led by Maulana M. A. Mannan, Convener of the Federation. Various issues involved were discussed in a free and cordial atmosphere.

In the meantime, the committee set up to draft the service rules for the teachers and other employees of various categories of non-government educational institutions has already completed the drafts and these are being sent to the various universities and education boards for their views.

After the views of the universities and the boards are obtained, steps would be taken for the introduction of uniform service rules and conditions of service for the teachers and other employees of various categories of institutions, viz, degree colleges, intermediate colleges, secondary schools and Madrashas.
