## Sattar administers oath: Shah Aziz PM, Jamal Dy PM

A forty-two-member Council of Ministers with Shah Azizur Rahman as Prime Minister was sworn-in on Friday afternoon at the Credential Hall of the Bangabhaban at a simple ceremony, reports BSS.

President Abdus Sattar administered the oath of office to twenty three cabinet ministers, fourteen state ministers and four deputy ministers.

Mr Aung Shew Prue Chowdhury

was sworn-in as State Minister in Dacca on Friday night. President Abdus Sattar administered the oath of office to Mr Chowdhury, who has been allocated the portfolio of Post, Telegraph and Telephones, Civil Aviation and Tourism.

Mr Chowdhury could not take the oath along with the other ministers in the afternoon as he was away from Dacca.

The President had earlier accepted the resignations of the members of the previous council of ministers.
