Homoeo college facing acute fund crisis

ISHURDI, July 12 : Ishurdi Homeopathy College, only one of its kind in this region has been facing acute financial crises barring its smooth functioning and development.

Besides fund stringency, the institution is plagued with accommodation crises; shortage of furniture, staff and books.

The college is still running in rented louse. It has no sufficient space to accommodate offices, library and class rooms at case. The class rooms are so small that students can not take seat there smoothly. The number of books in the library is very few. The library virtually cannot extend any help to the student.

There is no money in the college fund which is dependent on only tuition fees of the students that number 150 most of these students are

poor and can hardly pay fees regularly.

Although the number of students is increasing every year, but most of them come from the poor section of people. The college authority always tries in vain to realise tuition fees.

On an average, the teachers and employees of the college can draw only 30 to 40 per cent of their monthly salary.

The institution was established 10 years back. During this long period, it received no government financial assistance.

The college has not yet achieved affiliation of the concerned authority although it has fulfilled requisite condition.

When contacted, the Principal of the college said due to fund constraints the institution was facing closure. He wiled the government to extend financial support to the college.
