

Shibir activists go on rampage on Chittagong College campus

CHITTAGONG, July 27: Tension gripped the Chittagong College campus today as armed youths allegedly belonging to Chhatra Shibir went on a rampage there after police raided two hostels, reports UNB.

Police said they raided Sher-e-Bangla and Suhrawardy hostels Sunday and Monday nights to arrest the killers of Chittagong City Corporation Ward Commissioner and ruling party leader Liakat Ali Khan.

Commissioner Liakat Ali Khan was gunned down allegedly by Shibir cadres in front of his residence last month.

Police said the killers were now staying on the college campus, a stronghold of Jamaat's student front Islami Chhatra Shibir.

After the raids, some Shibir activists stormed into the residence of Principal Rawshan Akter Hanif at around 8pm on

Monday and damaged furniture.

As police raided the two hostels again at 9 pm, the Shibir activists went on a rampage on the campus damaging the office of Vice-Principal Sudhir Dev and some other offices.

The academic council of the college at an emergency meeting today condemned the attack on the residence of the principal.

It also formed a five-member committee, headed by Prof Abdus Salam of Mathematics Department, to investigate the incident.
