

College teachers threaten indefinite strike

The associations of the Lecturers and the Professors of Government Colleges reiterated that they would go for an indefinite strike and boycott the HSC and Degree examinations unless their 12-point demands were fulfilled immediately.

The Lecturers and the Professors of 233 Government Colleges, Education Directorate and Education Boards officials observed two-hour token strike by wearing black badges for the fourth day on Saturday in support of their demands.

Meanwhile, central leaders of the two associations called on Education Secretary and other senior officials on Saturday to discuss their demands.

A meeting of the central action committee of Engineers, Agriculturists, Doctors and BCS on Saturday demanded to stop DC, TNO and Magistrate to interfere with the duty of the college teachers in the examination centres.
