APSU call to maintain code of conduct

The All-Party Students' Unity (APSU) has appealed to the people, democratic forces and all political parties to maintain the election code of conduct in the ensuing Parliament elections.

APSU observed that after the ouster of the autocratic rule through mass upsurge, the election to the Jatiya Sangsad under a neutral temporary government is going to be held on February 27. APSU has also set up Students' Brigades throughout the country under its central leadership to make the polls free and fair.

The Students' Brigades will perform their duties during polls in the Dhaka city under the leadership of President and General Secretary of the Dhaka University unit and President and General Secretary of Dhaka Metropolitan unit while the district and upazila leadership will perform duties at districts and upazila levels, the APSU Press release added.

The Students' Brigades will also extend their support to the Election Commission and members of the law enforcing agencies so that the voters could exercise their franchise at the polling centres freely and without any fear.
