

APSU call for Nov 26 hartal

All-Party Students Unity (APSU) has called for observing dawn-to dusk countrywide hartal on November 26 in protest against the attack on its procession during the gherao programme on Saturday last.

The hartal call was given from a rally held in front of the National

Press Club on Monday in observance of the countrywide protest day.

Presided over by Mostafa Faruq, the rally was addressed by APSU leaders Fazlul Huq Milon, Faizul Hakim, Aminul Islam, and Khandaker Lutfur Rahman.

The APSU will bring out a torch procession in the city on November 25 in support of the hartal call and observe prisoners' release day on November 24.

Addressing the rally the student leaders said that the movement could not be stopped by employing armed miscreants. The movement for democracy will be continued till the total fall of the present government, they reiterated.

The rally was followed by a procession in the city streets. One round of gun fire was shot on the procession when it reached the Secretariat area, said the eyewitness.

The processionists also ransacked some vehicles on their way to the Motijheel area. At one stage, the APSU activists tried to proceed towards the Jatiya Party office at Allahwala Building. But they were intervened by the police immediately.
