APSU observes demonstration day today

All-Party Students Unity (APSU) has called for observing country-wide mass demonstration day today (Wednesday) to protest against the attack on its procession during the hartal hours on Tuesday.

The call was made from a rally held in front of the National Press Club on Tuesday. The rally was addressed by the APSU Leaders Amanullah 'Aman', Habibur Rahman Habib, Mostafizur Rahman Babul, Shafi Ahmed, S.M. Kamal Hossain and Nur Ahmed Bakul.

The student leaders alleged that their processions in different areas of the city were attacked during the hartal hours on Tuesday. APSU leader Nazmul Huq Pradhan was seriously injured by the "hired goons" they said.

The student leaders called to make the hartal programme of November 26 a success as a mark of protest against "such terrorist activities".

The APSU Dhaka University unit also held a rally near the TSC crossing of the university on Tuesday evening; in protest against the attack on its procession.
