APSU demands arrest of all corrupt ministers

DHAKA, Dec 18 (UNB): All Party Students Unity (APSU) today reiterated its demand to arrest all corrupt ministers of Ershad regime.

It expressed concern that most of the accomplices of Ershad were yet to be arrested though he himself was detained.
