## APSU demands arrest of corrupt bureaucrats

The All Party Students Unity (APSU) on Monday staged demonstration near the Secretariat building and submitted a memorandum to the secretary of Establishment demanding immediate arrest and trial of both the civil and military bureaucrats, engaged in corruption during the regime of the ousted President Ershad.

The APSU also demanded an Inquiry Committee to probe the corruption, misuse of power and mis-appropriation of public funds in all sectors during the autocratic regime.

Addressing a brief gathering near the Secretariat, the APSU leaders also demanded publication of a white paper on the corruption committee in different and semi-government offices during the Ershad government.

An eight-member delegation led by the APSU leader and General Secretary of Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) Khairul Kabir Khokon handed over the memorandum to the Establishment Secretary.

Meanwhile, the rally was addressed by the APSU leaders Faizul Hakim, Akhtar Sobhan Mashroor, Mosharraf Hossain and Razaul Karim Hiron.
