APSU demands speedy trial of Ershad

The All-Party Students Unity (APSU) on Monday strongly demanded speedy trial of ousted President Ershad, arrest and trial of his corrupt Ministers and MPs, collaborator-politicians, looter-businessmen and corrupt civil and military bureaucrats, reports BSS.

The APSU, in a rally in front of the National Press Club, cautioned that if General Ershad and his corrupt associates were not tried and given exemplary punishment, the student community would not leave the street.

Presided over by Chhatra League (S-A) President Shah Alam, the rally was addressed by DUCSU AGS Nazimuddin Alam, Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal Joint Convener Fazlul Huq Milon, Chhatra League (N-S) General Secretary Shafi Ahmed, Chhatra Union General Secretary Nasiruddoza, Chhatra Front General Secretary Bazlur Rashid Firoze and Jatiya Chhatra League General Secretary Kamal Hossain.

The student leaders called upon the interim government to withdraw false cases which were instituted against the student leaders during the Ershad regime.

They also urged the coming political government and the Opposition parties in and outside Parliament to work together to materialise the 10-point charter of demand of the APSU.

Chhatra Dal leader Fazlul Huq Milon condemned the reign of terror on the Dhaka University campus Sunday night and called for nabbing the holders of illegal arms. He said a vested quarter had been conspiring to tarnish the glorious image of the student community.

Chhatra League leader Shah Alam, in his presidential speech, said a sovereign Parliament would have to be established for parliamentary system of government.
